I Corinthians 13:1

When I became a man, I put away childish things.

Seven things that are childish

1. A child is the center of its own universe. Everything revolves around a child.
2. The child demands its own way.
3. The child is insensitive to others needs.
4. If the child doesn't get its own way, it will throw a tantrum.
5. A child is irresponsible. Children are not born obedient. They have to learn to be obedient.
6. A child is unable to reason.
7. A child only responds to concrete authority.

Luke 7:31-35

If you don't play by my rules, I don't want to play. That's childishness.

Manhood and Christlikeness are synonymous. A real man is Christ-like.

Two ways you can come into agreement:

1. Concrete authority
2. Abstract understanding
